

Langes, July 26, 1916.

Dear Mother

I received your letter on Saturday. Am glad you are having a good rest. I wish you take longer holiday but you will have to take a trip again soon.

Mr Nobbs came in Saturday and left a cheque for \$66⁰⁰ and 20 lbs of cherries. It is a Government Road cheque so am sending down to the Bank on Monday.

Mr Anderson came yesterday and brought his Mother with him. They are staying here. Jessie says Mrs Anderson is a second Aunt Pyatt. but she is not bad at all. Mr. Stord brought 20 lbs of Blackberries on Saturday. I will make jelly tomorrow.

I got the goods alright. It is very pretty. Almost too pretty for me. I will make it up when you come home. I wish if you have time you would get me a few yards of lace edging for curtain covers.

went to Gilberts for supper
