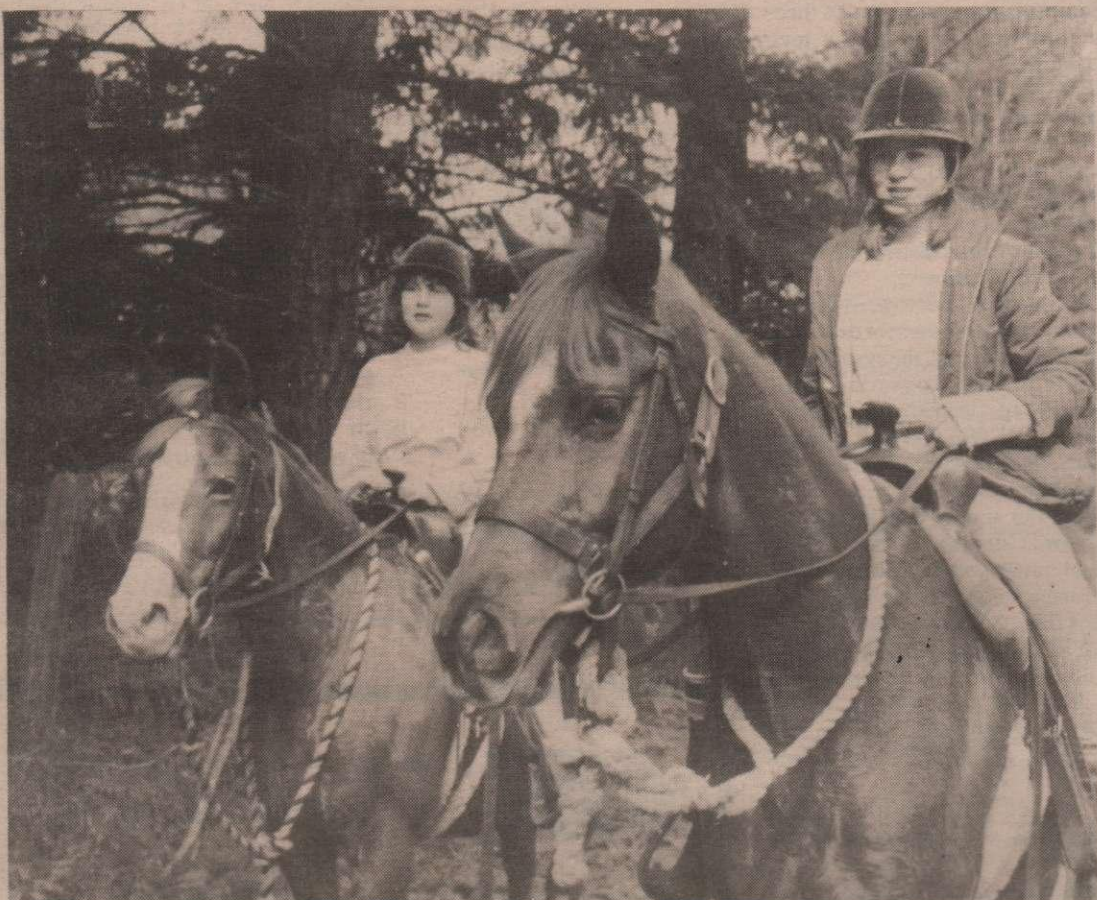

Horseback riders Marriah Grey (left) and Selky Middleton were seen enjoying the sunny weather last Saturday, as they rode their horses down Atkins Roads.

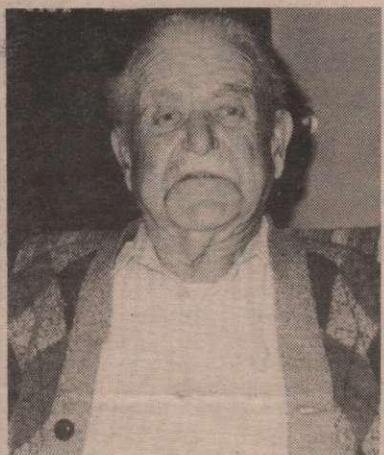

## Island, Legion will remember World War One vet, Bill Dodds

Bill Dodds had two reasons to celebrate each November: his birthday and Remembrance Day.

He represented a dwindling number of veterans until he died February 17. He survived the carnage of World War One.

Dodds was born in Newcastle, England, on November 10, 1895 and came with his family, at an early age, to Canada. They settled near Winnipeg and when hostilities broke out in 1914, Dodds joined a Winnipeg fighting unit for service in France.

He saw duty as a machine gunner during that world war and was part of

the Canadian contingent which captured Vimy Ridge. Dodds was with the occupation forces following the war and billeted with a Belgian family.

He fell in love with the daughter of his hosts. Her name was Germaine but she was only 16 at the time. When Dodds returned to Manitoba, he wrote to her. When she reached the age of 21, he sent her money for the passage to Canada and they were married in Montreal.

The Dodds' celebrated 50 years of marriage before she died several years ago.

Following the marriage, the young couple returned to Belgium where Dodds worked until the late summer of 1939. With the impending invasion by the German army, the Dodds set out for France by bicycle. But even France wasn't secure and they continued their flight to safety in England.

Upon return to Canada, the Dodds' lived in Manitoba where Dodds worked as a bookbinder in Winnipeg. They eventually retired to Salt Spring, living first in the Burgoyne Valley but later moving into Ganges.

After his wife died, Dodds moved into Greenwood. Age did not deter him from driving his car, however. Even after his health deteriorated, he would walk slowly to the Greenwoods' parking lot just to sit in the vehicle.

The Salt Spring Legion remembers Dodds for many reasons.

"He was always on parade for

Remembrance Day," said Legion president Ivan Mouat. That string of parades on November 11 included joining the few other WWI vets taking the salute in the march past a couple of years ago.

Mouat tells of a birthday party Dodds enjoyed at the Blain Road Legion. The old vet was to have been picked up from Greenwoods, taken to the Legion across the road and returned home after the party.

Just as the car was to leave to get him, someone noticed Dodds walking in company of two young ladies, one holding each arm.

At the Legion, he grinned his explanation: "They just won't keep away from me."

## Society needs site for the new pool

A spokesman with Salt Spring's swimming pool society says its main obstacle now is to find a site for its new pool.

Society president Wayne Taylor said the group is currently looking at between 12 and 15 sites for the new pool. It hopes to have more ideas by the weekend.

The outdoor pool, which measures 75 by 25 feet, is expected to arrive here from Smithers next month.

Taylor said approximately 25 people turned out to a public meeting called by the society last Sunday. A number of people agreed to sit on one

of several committees which will look into everything from finding a site to obtaining permits and membership fees.

Those committees are expected to report back to the main body at another general meeting this weekend.

Of concern now, Taylor said, is finding a central location where it won't be difficult to obtain the 38,000 gallons of water needed to fill the pool.

Because the pool is portable, the site used this year will not have to

## Callers express concern over apparent dumping

The Royal Canadian Navy's arrival in Ganges last Monday evening promptly prompted several calls to the Driftwood.

The callers, expressing concerns about the harbour, notified the news desk that the four vessels were pumping "raw sewage" into the water.

At the wharf, personnel on the four wooden-hulled vessels were taking part in sunset ceremonies. When the flags were lowered and stowed, the officer of the deck explained tersely, that no, the pumped liquid was not sewage.

A phone call to the duty officer of Maritime Forces Pacific (MAR-PAC) revealed the information that the vessels could, indeed, be veterans of the second world war. The duty officer also insisted, tersely, that the bilges would not require pumping to keep the boats afloat.

HMCS Fundy, HMCS Thunder, HMCS Cowichan and HMCS Maramichi pumped water — not sewage — into the harbour.

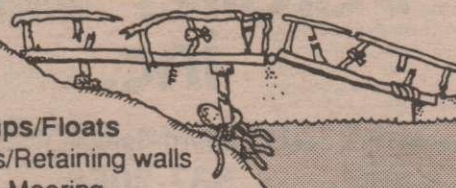

### What a silly word!

They are the only three English words in which the letter "g" is pronounced softly before "a" or "o".

I worked for many years for a man who insisted that in his next incarnation he would go for radio reporting. The written word is written forever, he complained.

Nor all thy tears wash out a word of it."*

Obviously Omar Khayyam was expressing his preference for the written word.

My late and former boss had it more clearly summed up. If he wrote a sentence, that sentence lives forever, somewhere. In years to come, perhaps centuries hence, someone, somewhere is likely to find a copy. The dweller in the future centuries would not exclaim, "How interesting!" All he will say is, "That nut couldn't spell!"

The radio or television reporter dies with the word he writes. His only concern is the pronunciation and 10 minutes later only the freak and the purist have remembered the strange pronunciation.

Like "margarine"; it's easy to write without comment. It's just the pronunciation that's amiss.

Margarine, I learned, is named after the name, Margaret. The original discovery of margarine found its crystals similar to a pearl. Margaret is a pearl and that ancestor of oleo oil gained its name with a hard "g". When oleomargarine was placed on the market it suddenly gained a soft "g". As the master of English usage, Fowler says, Margery won over Margaret.

### Where are they all?

The Practical Handyman's Encyclopedia: what thoughts of achievement that conjures up! And it's for sale at the Salt Spring Library. Only shortcoming is that the book for sale is volume one. If it's automobiles or astronomy or architecture you may find it adequately covered. But if it's water divining or well-digging or structural changes you plan on, then you're out of luck.

It isn't the only Lone Ranger in that library sale. They also have Funk and Wagnall's New Encyclopedia. There's a handy reference whether you are a handyman or not! But it comes only in volume one. Same problem arises. Stick to the "A's" or don't bother!

But what worries me most of all is what happened to the other volumes? Does it mean that some proud owner of a set of handyman's references is stymied for hints on automatic transmission or adding machines or whatever? And the other encyclopedia is worse. If somebody is storing the rest of the set, is it really a Funk and Wagnall encyclopedia? Or just a Wagnall?

Who are the mysterious donors who dispose of their encyclopedias one volume at a time? The volumes are still there if you're interested. I wasn't! My forte is "travel" and there ain't no "T's" in volume one.

## NSSWD issues tax bills

The North Salt Spring Waterworks District (NSSWD) has issued tax bills for 1990.

For property covering 0.4 hectares (one acre) or less, the levy stands at \$100. The tax increases to \$110 for property of 0.4 hectares to two hectares (one to five acres) and to \$120 for property sized from two hectares to four hectares (five to 10 acres). Anything above four hectares comes with a tag of \$130.

The waterworks district currently serves 1,500 customers.

The tax levied goes toward paying off the capital improvement debt. Between 1976 and 1982, the system was expanded and upgraded and ratepayers experienced a series of tax increases. By 1983, the levy was set at a basic \$100 and has remained at that level since.

When the annual meeting of the waterworks district comes up on April 24, ratepayers will be choosing one trustee to sit on the board of trustees for a three year term.

The rules for the election require that nominations for the position must be "made in writing, duly signed, seconded" and given to the waterworks office before noon on April 2.

A further rule stipulates that "nominations will not be accepted from the floor." Nominees must be Canadians, of voting age, and ratepayers in good standing of the water district.

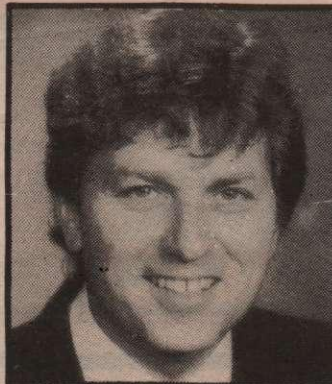
The trustees currently are Hart Graham, chairman, Don Storr, Eric Alderson, Bud Keech and John Lusney. Storr ends his term on the board this year.

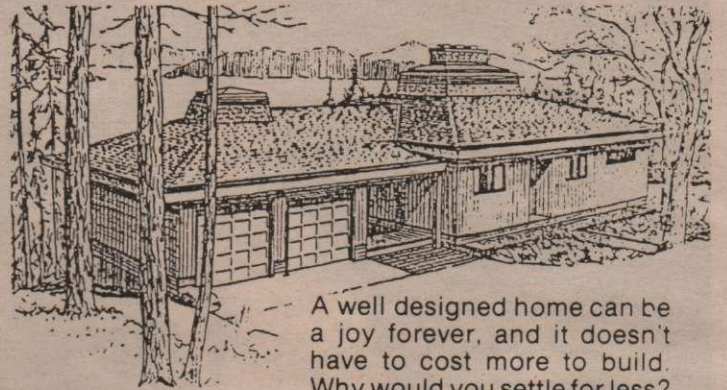

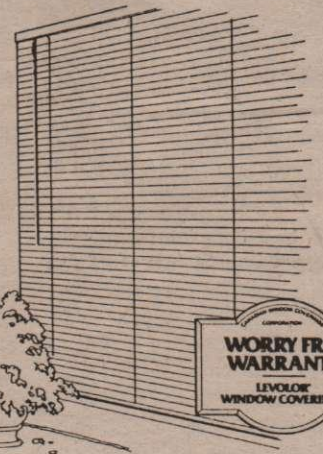

# Pool Society seeks input from the community

site used this year will not have to become its permanent home.

Although Taylor noted nothing has been "etched in stone," he said the group is initially planning to run the pool four months a year — from May through to the end of August.

This could also change depending on the feed back from the community.

In the meantime, Taylor added, members from the swimming pool society met with representatives from the Parks and Recreations Com-

mission last week to discuss the relationship between the two groups.

He said some of the arrangements which need to be worked out include liability insurance, staffing and programming.

He also noted that about half of the \$15,000 needed to buy the pool has been raised by the group so far. It is hoped the rest will come either from donations or private individuals and groups willing to lend the money in the form of low-interest loans. These loans will be paid back through user and membership fees.

The non-profit swimming pool society formed about four years ago

with the intention of bringing a swimming pool to Salt Spring. Taylor said the group decided to go with this option because the pool comes at no cost to the taxpayer. He added that attempts to bring a pool here in the past have usually failed because the more elaborate pools proposed in the past would have meant an increase in taxes.

Taylor also noted the need to have a pool has become increasingly clear as the number of people wanting to participate in swim programs has outgrown the amount of private-pool space made available for community use.

An estimated 370 primary school children alone will be eligible to par-

ticipate in swim programs this year.

Last year, Taylor said, the program could only accommodate 250 children.

The society will be holding another general meeting at the United Church this Sunday, beginning at 3 p.m.

Taylor said any additional input would be welcome.

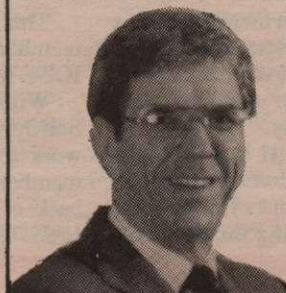

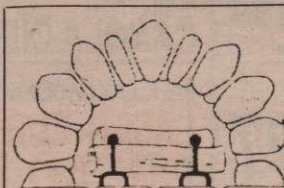

# Sea Cadets to visit Ganges

This weekend, 25 sea cadets and six of their officers will travel to Salt Spring Island from Esquimalt aboard two of the 75-foot vessels generally used in training drills.

En route to Salt Spring, they will practice some typical cadet skills, including Fire on Board and, of course, Man Over Board. Once here, the group will drop anchor and settle in for the night.

Commanding officer Lieutenant Alan Hoban hopes that while they're here, the cadets will manage to attract a few more interested members.

The group comes from Sidney where the youngsters, aged 12 to 18, make up a corp of the 35-member Admiral Budget Sea Cadet Corp.

The types of activities they'll be performing over the weekend, Hoban

says, is similar to what the group does most of the year. He adds, however, some training expeditions last for a few weeks or more and there are occasions when the members will make shorter voyages on board destroyers or mine sweepers out of Esquimalt.

Some cadets have been at sea for six weeks or longer with the navy.

One thing for sure, Hoban adds, by the time the cadets leave at the age of 19, they'll know everything there is to know about sailing, charting boats, and military drills.

Hoban says the purpose of the cadets is not to turn out a collection

of "sailors and soldiers," but rather to teach discipline and help its recruits understand the concept of responsibility.

Both these skills are something the members will be able to draw on the rest of their lives, he says.

The organization was established in 1910 and is jointly funded by the Navy League of Canada and the Department of National Defence. Hoban says all of the equipment and uniforms used by the cadets are provided by those two groups.

The skills members acquire generally relate to sea activities.

They include learning to sail, tie knots, navigation, first aid and working with radios.

Playing in the Sea Cadets band is another feature which draws some of the young people to this particular group.

However, Hoban adds, the life-skills the cadet corp works to teach its recruits are of equal importance. The focus of those, he adds, is how to take orders and give them. And that, he says, is something the cadets learn on their long and difficult struggle through the ranks.

"As they climb through the ranks,

they become more responsible and they get more authority. Eventually they can take charge of smaller groups and that helps them learn leadership skills."

Hoban says training the youngsters for a life in the military is not what the sea cadets is all about, although he adds the group offers a basic understanding of life in the military.

Instead, he says, the cadet corp works to produce teenagers who "respect citizenship, appreciate their fellow man and their country."

"The kids that come here are looking for the challenge and the discipline — they are looking for a chance to do what they are told."

The cadets' vessels will arrive at the government dock in Ganges at 2

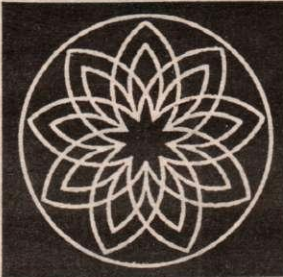



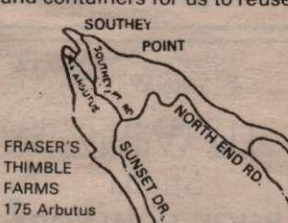
