
## Kanaka: Places & Names



## **ACROSS**

- 4. Now a Provicial Park. Hawaiian immigrants who settled on the island in the 1880s also farmed there. (2 words)
- Once a fort, now a capital, Kanakas lived here in Kanaka Row
- Settled by Hawaiians as early as 1886, this small island at the mouth of Salt Spring's Fulford Harbour still has the centuryold Kanaka house on it. (2 words)
- Main harbour at southern end of Salt Spring Island (2 words)
- 13. Trading post on the Fraser River (2 words)
- 14. a place to tie small boats (3 words)
- A small island, settled by Kanaka, located just off the Saanich Peninsula (2 words)
- 16. Hawaiian settlement at Fort Vancouver
- 17. Ruckle Park is located here (2 words)
